## CRAFT & HOBBY

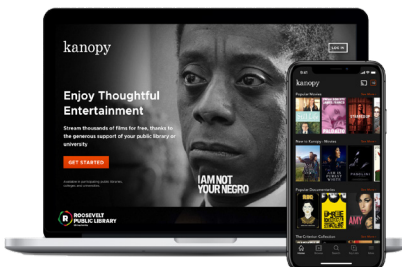

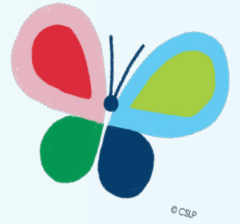

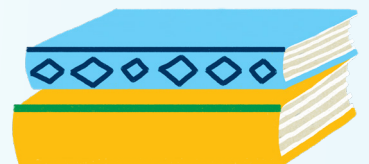
